COVID-19 SAFETY AND COMPLIANCE – PLEASE READ:

The State of Georgia leads in the Reopening of America following the Coronavirus-19 Pandemic. In order for the DeKalb GOP to host a safe and responsible in-person event and in response to Covid-19, we are keeping in mind with [CDC Considerations for Events and Gatherings](#) and aligning with the ongoing guidance for reviving a healthy Georgia with Governor Brian Kemp’s guidance for Empowering a Healthy Georgia in response to COVID-19 which was updated on [January 15, 2021](#) and runs through 11:59 PM on January 31, 2021 unless renewed by the Governor. We are also adhering to Governor Kemp’s [“Safety Promise” Campaign](#) to Urge Georgians to Heed Public Health Guidance.

As such, the DeKalb GOP has made the following changes for our in-person Breakfasts in response to COVID-19 as follows:

- All registrations via EventBrite are required in advance.
 - There will be no day of, walk-ups permitted.
 - Payment via cash, credit or e-cash (i.e. Venmo, PayPal) will not be accepted at the door.
- A hot breakfast with juice and coffee will be included. A server who will be wearing a mask and gloves will serve and administer the buffet – so no self-serving will be allowed. The breakfast line will have marked spots that will be six feet apart to allow for social distancing.
- Masks are recommended for DeKalb GOP Members and Guests. If wearing one than you are to provide your own mask.
- All Georgians can personally commit to the Georgia Safety Promise by following basic safety guidelines when in public spaces, including practicing social distance, wearing a face covering, washing and sanitizing hands, and supporting businesses that have committed to the Georgia Safety Promise.
- We will have access to the entire dining area of Wild Wings Café allowing for reserved seating to be in compliance with no more than 10 people at the same table and being 6 feet apart between tables.

SAVE THE DATES:

Every two years and in each odd-numbered year, the GAGOP will have multiple elections that are referenced or known as conventions. The convention is open to all Republican members of the public with the intention of electing new party leadership to your local precinct, your county, your congressional district, and then statewide. Locations will be announced shortly. In the interim, we kindly ask that you “Save the Dates”.

voted on at the County Convention. If there is competition for an office, the committee may recommend a candidate or not, and even a qualified candidate may be nominated on the floor of the convention.
