You can also register as a walk-up on Saturday morning, but pre-registration saves you time and, if for some reason you cannot make it, your information will be pre-printed on the delegate forms (someone else from your precinct will still have to be there to actually elect you if you cannot make the caucus meeting). All DeKalb County Residents who are legally registered to vote and who believe in the principles of the Republican Party are urged to participate in the process.

## Get Involved 2021

**Step 1**  
**March 20, 2021**  
**Start in your neighborhood**

**Precinct Caucus (Mass Meeting)**

Early involvement begins at the grassroots level in your voting precinct. At 10 AM on this date, your county will gather at a designated place (watch your newspaper, county website, state website, or emails for the exact location). At this caucus, you will elect Delegates & Alternates to your County Convention held on a date certain and conduct all other necessary and proper business. In each odd-numbered year you shall also elect precinct officers (2 year terms) and precinct committeemen.

**NOTE:** Although you do not have to be present in Step 1 to be elected as a Delegate or Alternate from your precinct, at least one person must be present from your precinct in order to caucus. Attendance increases your chances of attending the County, District and State Conventions as a Delegate or Alternate.

**Step 2**  
**April 17, 2021**  
**County Convention**

Under 80,000 population will hold precinct caucuses at 9 AM immediately prior to the county convention. DeKalb County GOP will hold a convention at 10 AM on this date at a place designated by the county party. If you are an elected Delegate or Alternate, you will receive a notice of the location. Delegates who were elected at the Mass Meeting or Caucus will gather, and in odd-numbered years shall elect officers for the party in the respective counties for the next two years and adopt any new or amended existing rules pursuant to Rule 9.8, and which in both odd-numbered and in presidential election years shall elect delegates and alternates to the Congressional District and State Conventions and conduct all other necessary and proper business.

**Step 3**  
**May 15, 2021**  
**District Convention**

These are based on U.S. Congressional Districts. Locations are decided by each individual district. If you were elected as a Delegate or Alternate to the District Convention, then you will be notified of the location.

**At This Convention:**

The Delegates shall in odd-numbered years elect officers, district committee members, and State Committee members for the next two years, adopt any new or amended rules pursuant to Rule 9.8, and conduct all other necessary and proper business, which in presidential election years, shall elect Delegates and Alternates to the Republican National Convention.


**Step 4**  
**June 4-5, 2021**  
**State Convention**  
**\*See note below**

If you are an elected Delegate or Alternate you will receive a notice of the location. In odd-numbered years, you will:

- Elect a New State Chairman (2 year term)
- Elect other State Party Officers (2 year term)

In even-numbered years you shall elect the National Committeeman and National Committeewoman (4 year terms), as well as Delegates-At-Large to the Republican National Convention.

\*Due to COVID restrictions and pursuant to GAGOP Rule 9.14, the date(s) and/or venue (including virtuality) of the State Convention may be changed by the GAGOP Executive Committee. The final date(s) and/or venue of the State Convention shall be determined by the GAGOP Executive Committee based upon availability and existing COVID restrictions.

## Trump's influence on state GOP endures

Democrats energized voters in presidential and Senate elections.

Over the past four years, a blue wave swept away every GOP state legislator in DeKalb County and drove huge margins that helped Joe Biden flip the state in November and powered the Democratic wins in January's U.S. Senate runoffs.

But as DeKalb GOP Chair Lane Flynn's term expires, he expects to cede the reins of the county's party to a pro-Donald Trump activist who wants to pull the organization further toward the former president's political brand.

"Personally, I'm not convinced that the Trump-iest candidate will be the most viable in our area," Flynn said. "But Trump's role will be whatever he wants it to be. He can play kingmaker and

he'll still have influence."

The tilt toward the right in the deeply Democratic stronghold is but one illustration of Trump's enduring grip on the Georgia GOP.

Trump has been out of office for almost two months after a chaotic term in the White House, but his influence in Georgia politics
