

**Instructions on How to Testify**

Anyone wishing to testify should arrive at the Georgia Capitol around 12:30 PM -1:00 PM on Monday to get parked, clear security and to make their way to Room #307. You should arrive at the

hearing **NO LATER THAN 2:00 PM** in order to be in line to sign up to testify. Once in line, do not get out of line until you've signed up, or until they are no longer accepting signatures. If are not able to secure a slot to testify than we still encourage you to stay at the hearing to show your support of SB377. It is also recommended that you prepare your comments in advance and keep your commentary to 2 minutes or less.
