Logic and Accuracy (L&A) Testing is a collection of pre-election procedures that ensure that the voting equipment and ballots to be used in an upcoming election can be properly display the ballot, collect votes, and tabulate votes.

This test is conducted in accordance with Section 21-2-379.25(c) of the Official Code of Georgia, Annotated. The test procedures are open to the public. Testing will continue daily until completed. The Superintendent will have a representative on-site to answer questions during the first hour of each phase. Representatives of political parties or bodies and the media are entitled to be present during testing.

SIGN UP FOR EARLY VOTING POLL WATCHING

Thank you so much for volunteering to be an Early Voting Poll Watcher during the DeKalb County Republican Mid-Term Elections and for your patriotic support!

There will be three shifts of 1 poll watcher per day at each early voting precinct.

Weekdays: Shift One will be from 6:30 am to 10:30 am. Shift Two will be from 10:30 am to 3 pm. Shift Three will be from 3 pm to approximately 7:30 pm.

Saturdays (October 22 & October 29): Shift One will be from 7:30 AM to 11:30 am, Shift Two will be from 11:30 am to 2:30 pm, and Shift Three will be from 2:30 pm to approximately 6:30 PM.

Sundays (October 23 & October 30): Shift One will be from 11:30 am to 2:30 pm and Shift Two from 2:30 pm to approximately 5:30 pm.

Kindly note the following:

The DeKalb GOP will provide you with more information regarding the issuance of your badge and credential letter. You will then pick your badge/credentials in-person starting on October 14 at 1 PM at the DeKalb Voter Registration and Elections Office which is located at 4380 Memorial Drive, Suite 300, Decatur, GA 30032-1239. Please bring a hard copy of your authorization letter along with your driver's license/ID.

Parties may pick up credential packets for poll watchers by showing their ID along with the designation letter of the poll watcher(s). That person must sign up for the credentials.

You will be standing for long periods of time, it is strongly recommended that you wear comfortable clothing and shoes. You cannot wear any campaign type of clothing.

Training is required and will be available via Zoom. There will be several live sessions of training, on demand training will be available as well. All volunteers will also have to review the training manual.

As a poll watcher, you will also be observing the set-up and/or break down of the precinct. There will be three shifts per day, excluding Sundays, comprised of one person per shift/precinct.

You will receive your authorization letter via email from the DeKalb GOP. PLEASE NOTE THAT AUTHORIZATION LETTERS ARE ONLY ISSUED ON EACH THURSDAY FOR THE FOLLOW WEEK'S SCHEDULE. Please plan ahead as once the weekly list of watchers is submitted we cannot add anymore watchers to the following week's schedule.

All Republicans and Patriots are welcome to [volunteer](#) to observe the elections. **You do not need to be a Georgia and/or DeKalb County Resident.** If you are coming in from out-of-town or state, you will have to make your own travel and transportation arrangements. There will not be any compensation or reimbursements.

Earliest day to apply for an absentee ballot for the November, 2022 General Election

SEP 20, 2022

Earliest day for registrar to mail an UOCAVA absentee ballot and Ranked Choice Ballot for the November, 2022 General Election

OCT 10, 2022

Earliest day for a registrar to mail a regular absentee ballot for the November General Election

OCT 11, 2022

Last day for a person to register and be eligible to vote in the November, 2022 election

OCT 17, 2022

Advanced (Absentee in-person) Voting begins for the November, 2022 election

OCT 22, 2022

Mandatory Saturday Voting for the November election

OCT 23, 2022

Optional Sunday Voting for the November election. Check with your Registrar.

OCT 28, 2022

Last day to submit absentee ballot application for the November General Election

OCT 30, 2022

Optional Sunday Voting for the November General Election

Applying for an Absentee Ballot

How to request an absentee ballot for the Midterm General Elections.

Now: Download and submit an [Absentee Ballot Application](#)

October 28: Last day to submit an absentee application

November 8: Election Day (Last day for us to receive your absentee ballot by 7 PM)

Important Information: The law on absentee ballots has changed. You may **only** use the official application above to request an absentee ballot. Read the application carefully. You are now required to provide either a Georgia Driver's License or Georgia ID Card number or a copy of another form of ID. If you do not have an acceptable ID, you can get one free of charge from our office or the Department of Driver Services. Click [here](#) for more information about Georgia's ID requirements.

After the close of advance voting, you can still deliver your ballot by hand to the front desk of the Voter Registration and Elections Office during our business hours, weekdays 8 am - 4:30 pm; or until 7 pm on election day.

Changed your mind and want to vote in person? No problem. As long as you have not returned your absentee ballot, you can go to your polling location and vote in person instead. If possible, bring your absentee ballot with you.
