It is time to ensure **FITness – Faith & Integrity & Trust** in our elections.

Please join us as a **DeKalb GOP Early Voting Poll Watcher** and an **Election Day Poll Watcher** for the General Mid-Term Election in DeKalb County, Georgia. There will be **19 days of Early Voting inclusive of two Saturdays and two Sundays** with **15 precincts** to monitor and **three shifts of one per-day**. **Six** of these early voting precincts will also have absentee drop boxes available during published early voting hours. While we want to have 100% coverage for all dates, times and locations, it is our minimum goal to have complete coverage of the opening and closing shifts of the six precincts that have drop boxes.

All Republicans and Patriots are welcome to [volunteer](#) to observe the elections. **You do not need to be a Georgia and/or DeKalb County Resident.** If you are coming in from out-of-town or state, you will have to make your own travel and transportation arrangements. There will not be any compensation or reimbursements


We need all hands-on deck to **#VoteDeKalbRed** and are counting on you to make this happen. It's time to make sure that you are ready to vote Republican up and down the ballot this November. These will be the most important Midterm Elections in our history so it's critical that YOU are ready to get to the polls in Georgia. We're counting on YOU to do your part TODAY.

- Being able to vote early, including on the two weekends leading up to Election Day, gives voters more opportunities to cast their votes at the polls.
- Early voting provides flexibility to voters who can't take time off to vote during the week or if out-of-pocket on Election Day.
- Having more days for voting means faster and more efficient Election Day lines.
- Early voting can lead to more reminders about upcoming elections.
- Early voting also helps candidates and campaigns do more focused outreach to constituents.

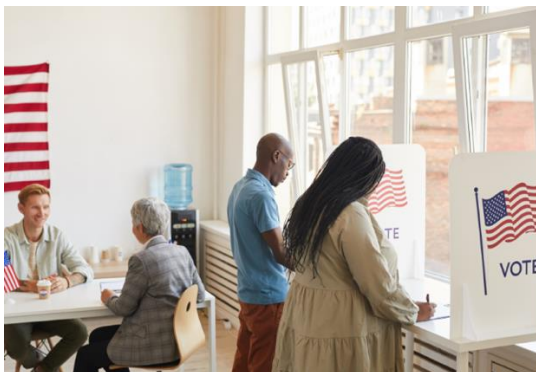

AUG 22, 2022

Earliest day to apply for an absentee ballot for the November, 2022 General Election

SEP 20, 2022

Earliest day for registrar to mail an UOCAVA absentee ballot and Ranked Choice Ballot for the November, 2022 General Election

OCT 10, 2022

Earliest day for a registrar to mail a regular absentee ballot for the November General Election

OCT 11 2022

Last day for a person to register and be eligible to vote in the November, 2022 election

OCT 17, 2022

Advanced (Absentee in-person) Voting begins for the November, 2022 election

OCT 22, 2022

Mandatory Saturday Voting for the November election

OCT 23, 2022

Optional Sunday Voting for the November election. Check with your Registrar.

OCT 28, 2022

Last day to submit absentee ballot application for the November General Election

OCT 30, 2022

Optional Sunday Voting for the November General Election

Applying for an Absentee Ballot

How to request an absentee ballot for the Midterm General Elections.

Now: Download and submit an [Absentee Ballot Application](#)

October 28: Last day to submit an absentee application

November 8: Election Day (Last day for us to receive your absentee ballot by 7 PM)

Important Information: The law on absentee ballots has changed. You may **only** use the official application above to request an absentee ballot. Read the application carefully. You are now required to provide either a Georgia Driver's License or Georgia ID Card number or a copy of another form of ID. If you do not have an acceptable ID, you can get one free of charge from our office or the Department of Driver Services. Click [here](#) for more information about Georgia's ID requirements.

After the close of advance voting, you can still deliver your ballot by hand to the front desk of the Voter Registration and Elections Office during our business hours, weekdays 8 am - 4:30 pm; or until 7 pm on election day.

Changed your mind and want to vote in person? No problem. As long as you have not returned your absentee ballot, you can go to your polling location and vote in person instead. If possible, bring your absentee ballot with you.
