We inspired a slate of incredible candidates who had the courage to run for office and for many that never dreamed of being a politician. The DeKalb Republican Party has become the party of the grassroots in our quest to **#VoteDeKalbRed** and Keep Georgia on the Right Track.

Officers and retain a majority in the General Assembly. All of which received over 2 Million votes each outperforming Stacey Abrams who received only 1.8 Million total votes. Additionally, Jen Jordan (AG Candidate) and Charlie Bailey (Lt. Gov Candidate) all received more votes than Stacey.

Gov Candidate) all received more votes than Stacey. **Herschel Walker** and Raphael Warnock both received 1.9 M votes but this race fell short of the 50 + 1 mark forcing a Run-Off. *(Note: Warnock was the highest performing Democrat in Georgia indicating he may have hit his ceiling if Republicans, Conservatives and Right- Leaning Independents return to the polls to vote for Herschel in the Run-Off).*

While our slate of DeKalb Republican Candidates did not have the outcome that we had hoped for, there is no reason to sell ourselves short that a Red Wave never materialized. As we pivot into four weeks of overtime; let's take a brief time out to celebrate our many victories. We stopped Stacey and

kept her out of the governor's mansion. I am also pleased to share with you that in the General election, the efforts put forth by the DeKalb Republican Party and, due to our **slate of 17 candidates, increased Republican voter turnout by 11 percent in the Governor's Race from 2018 to 2022 in DeKalb County.** *(Our goal was 10% and we moved the needle 11%).* We **reduced the number of votes by 20,000 for Stacey Abrams and increased Governor Brian Kemp's scorecard by 5,500 votes with a net gain of over 25,500 votes from the second bluest county.** For the first time in decades, we challenged the Democrats, put forth formidable opponents and made them work harder in a place that they thought was their Blue Wall.

We restored **FITness - Faith, Integrity and Trust** in our elections by building working relationships with our elections' officials, stakeholders and partners **Tea Party Patriots' Election Integrity Network** and **Georgia Victory** which made it harder to cheat and easier to vote for millions of Georgians. We also trained and deployed hundreds of poll watchers, absentee ballot observers and vote review panelists. We empowered a GOTV engine comprised of volunteers and paid canvassers to build partnerships with **GAGOP/Georgia Victory, Citizens for a Greater Georgia, Turning Point USA, Team Herschel, Governor Kemp's Campaign, Landmark Communications** and the **Atlanta Republican Jewish Coalition**. Through these partnerships and in conjunction with our own campaigns, the DeKalb GOP was able to connect with tens of thousands of voters for **#VoteDeKalbRed Days**, Events and Meet & Greets. Through the generosity of our **DeKalb GOP Members and Investors**. We created a digital infrastructure and ground game that that ultimately saved Georgia. We formed a team who became family to rebuild an organization that most people thought was an impossibility and was dormant.



While **#TeamDeKalbGOP** may be the underdog, I am very confident that we will provide the lift to take back the U.S. Senate by **electing Herschel Walker** in the runoff. **#VoteDeKalbRed** is a journey and we only have just begun. I am so proud of **#TeamDeKalbGOP**.

IMPORTANT: Runoff Details from Team Herschel

It is now **26 days** until election day on December 6th!

- ✓ **Early Voting Dates:** Early voting will begin in DeKalb County on Saturday, November 26 and conclude on Friday, December 2.
- ✓ **Evict Warnock Bus Tour:** Team Herschel is hitting the road to Evict Raphael Warnock from the U.S. Senate! The schedule is still being confirmed, as the team has been forced into a quick turnaround. Please be on the lookout for more details regarding where Herschel will be.
- ✓ **Volunteers/Voter Outreach:** There is no more single important aspect to a runoff election than voter outreach and GOTV efforts. Many Republicans from all over the state did not show up to vote on November 8th, and we cannot let that happen on December 6th. Team Herschel needs as many volunteers as possible to help get voters to the polls. Whether that is knocking on doors, phone banking, putting up signs, or helping work events, your volunteer efforts will help determine the balance of power in the U.S. Senate.

RUN OFF TIMELINE

Pre-runoff timeline

- **Nov. 15:** Counties must certify their Nov. 8 election results by this day.
- **Nov. 16:** The state will randomly determine which batches of ballots are to be reviewed in a risk-limiting audit mandated by Georgia law.
- **Nov. 17:** Counties will begin a [risk-limiting audit](#) of the Georgia election for secretary of state.
- **Nov. 18:** State officials are asking counties to aim to complete their audits in one day, finishing by Friday the 18th.
- **Nov. 25:** The Georgia Secretary of State's Office must certify the statewide Nov. 8 results by this day.

For voting early in person

- **Nov. 26:** This day, a Saturday, would be the earliest day that early in-person voting could begin in any county, according to state officials. Whether there is early in-person voting on this day will be a county-by-county decision, on whether they want to offer weekend early voting. No early voting occurs the weekend directly before the runoff day (which will be the weekend of Dec. 3-4).
- **Nov. 28:** All Georgia counties will begin early in-person voting on this Monday.
- **Dec. 2:** Early in-person voting will conclude on this Friday after running one week.

For voting by absentee:

- **Now:** You [can currently request](#) an absentee ballot. (click this link for a [printable version of the request form](#) or [visit the Secretary of State's online request portal here](#).)
- **Nov. 28:** All request applications must be received by this time. Make sure you mail the request well in advance of this day so that you can be confident your election office will receive it in time.
- **Dec. 6:** Absentee ballots must be received by the close of polls on the day of runoff voting. You can use a drop box to ensure it is received on time or make sure to mail it to your election office several days in advance so you can be sure it gets there on time.
